Steinar Våge is president of ConocoPhillips Norge (Norway). He is located in Stavanger, Norway.

Våge began his career with Phillips in 1988 and had various engineering positions in Norway from 1988 to 1995. From 1995 to 2000, he held positions at Phillips headquarters in Bartlesville, Oklahoma, in the E&P International New Venture group and Corporate Planning and Strategic Transactions group. From 2000 to 2002, he served as commercial director for Phillips E&P in Stavanger. From 2002 to 2004, he held the position of manager, Partner Operations, Business Development and Commercial, of ConocoPhillips UK, located in Aberdeen, and later for the North Sea business unit, located in Stavanger. From 2004 to 2007, he held positions in Venezuela as general manager of the heavy oil Joint Ventures Petrozuata and Petrolera Ameriven.

Våge has served on the board for the Norwegian Oil Industry Association (OLF) since 2007 and is currently chairman of the board.

Våge is a Norwegian citizen and received a bachelor of science degree in petroleum engineering in 1987 and a master of science degree in reservoir engineering in 1991, from the Rogaland Regional College in Stavanger, Norway.

A short historic perspective of the Ekofisk Area and the start of the oil and gas industry in Norway. Discuss ConocoPhillips current operations, activities and portfolio in Norway and opportunities for the future. ConocoPhillips is preparing the Ekofisk Area for 40 more years and is in the process of testing new technology like Life of field seismic systems, Subsea water injection, Integrated operations, onshore operation of offshore facilities and new well completion techniques. Three new platforms are now under construction for installation in the period 2013 – 2015 in the Ekofisk Area which are key elements to secure production for another 40 years.
